

TOWN OF CANTERBURY
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING
May 20, 2016

Roy Piper called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The meeting was held in the Community Room, 1 Municipal Drive, Canterbury, CT. Mr. Piper led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Piper asked for nominations for moderator. Ed Grab nominated Robert Droesch for moderator and the motion was seconded by Ellen Chalfant. Kim Kelly made a motion to close nominations and Bill Chalfant seconded the motion. A vote was taken on this motion. Motion carried. A vote was taken for moderator and Mr. Droesch was elected moderator.

The clerk read the warning.

Roy Piper made a motion to discuss Item #1, which was seconded by Kim Kelly. Item #1: To hear and discuss the latest status of the State of Connecticut's Budget for fiscal year 2016/2017, as it pertains to revenues to the Town of Canterbury. Mr. Piper explained what was happening with the Town budget moving forward. Discussion followed.

Kim Kelly made a motion to approve Item #2, which was seconded by Ellen Chalfant. Item #2: To discuss and act upon the proposed amended Town Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Fees for Building Permits" to adopt revised permit fee schedule as recommended By the Board of Selectmen and the Building Official. Melissa Gil, the Zoning Enforcement Officer, gave an explanation of the proposed ordinance. Vote taken. Ordinance approved.

Ellen Chalfant made a motion to approve Item #3, which was seconded by Kim Kelly. Item #3: To consider and act upon the following resolution: "RESOLVED: that the Board of Selectmen are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into an agreement with the Commissioner of Transportation, State of Connecticut, for the expenditure of all highway funds and Local Capital Improvement Funds to become available to the Town of Canterbury from said highway funds and Local Capital Improvement Funds for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016 under the provisions of Section 13a-175(a) (D), Connecticut General Statutes." Vote taken

Roy Piper made a motion to adjourn and Kim Kelly seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 7:20 pm.
