

TOWN OF CANTERBURY
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING – JUNE 2, 2016

Roy A. Piper called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The meeting was held in the Community Room, 1 Municipal Drive, Canterbury, CT. Mr. Piper led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Piper asked for nominations from the floor for meeting Moderator. Neil Dupont nominated Robert Droesch and Jeannette Kildea seconded the motion. Kim Kelly made a motion to close nominations and Neil Dupont seconded the motion. A vote was taken to close nominations. Motion carried. A vote was taken for moderator and Mr. Droesch was elected.

The clerk read the warning.

Jeannette Kildea made a motion which was seconded by Kim Kelly to discuss Item #1. Item #1: To hear and discuss the General Government Budget for the Town of Canterbury for the fiscal year July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 and to approve appropriations for such fiscal year in the amount of \$2,864,336.00 as recommended by the Board of Finance. Discussion followed. Motion was made by Neil Dupont and seconded by Ellen Chalfant to close discussion. Vote taken. Motion carried.

Neil Dupont made a motion which was seconded by Jeannette Kildea to discuss Item #2. Item #2: To hear and discuss the Education Budget for the Town of Canterbury for the fiscal year July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 and to approve appropriations for such fiscal year in the amount of \$11,471,059.00 as recommended by the Board of Finance. Discussion followed. Motion was made by Roy Piper and seconded by Jeannette Kildea to close discussion. Vote taken. Motion carried.

Kim Kelly made a motion which was seconded by Jeannette Kildea to discuss Item #3. Item #3: To hear and discuss the Capital Improvement Plan Budget for the Town of Canterbury for the fiscal year July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 and to approve appropriations for such fiscal year in the amount of \$337,000.00 as recommended by the Board of Finance. Discussion followed. Jeannette Kildea made a motion which was seconded by Kim Kelly to close discussion. Vote taken. Motion carried.

NOTE: By order of the Board of Selectmen, a vote on Items 1, 2, and 3 will be adjourned to a Referendum to be held on Wednesday, June 8, 2016 at the Municipal Building between the hours of 6:00am and 8:00pm.

Neil Dupont made a motion which was seconded by Lou Pecoraro to approve Item #4. Item #4: To approve “in principle” the five-year Capital Improvement Plan as adopted by the Capital Improvement Plan Committee and the Board of Selectmen. A copy of the Plan is available in the Town Clerk’s Office. Vote taken. Motion carried with one person abstaining.

Kim Kelly made a motion which was seconded by Jeannette Kildea to approve Item #5. Item #5: To see whether the voters will authorize that a summary of the previously adopted ordinance entitled “An Ordinance Establishing Fees for Building Permits” be published in lieu of the entire text of the adopted ordinance, pursuant to the authorization of Section 7-157(b) of the General Statutes.

Roy Piper made a motion to adjourn and Jeannette Kildea seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 7:35 pm.
